Maths	Our unit is: Place Value This week we are learning place value to 1,000,000 / more or less than / partitioning numbers.
Reading	Our unit is based on the book: The Storm Keepers Island by Catherine Doyle This week we are looking at inference and exploring new vocabulary
Writing	Our unit is based on the book: Queen of the Falls by Chris Van Allsburg This week we are writing a postcard to a friend to describe how amazing Niagara Falls is and why they should visit using a range of punctuation.
Computing	Our unit is: Computing systems and networks - systems and searching This week we are learning to recognise the role of computer systems in our lives.
Geography History	Our unit is: Sow, Grow, Farm This week we are discussing the question: Can you describe in detail the different types of agricultural land use in the UK?
Music	Our unit is: Exploring and Analysing the Elements of Music This week we are developing our understanding of beat, rhythm and pulse. We will be listening to and analysing a range of music from different genres.
Art	Our unit is: Nature's Art This week we are answering the question: Can you produce creative work on a theme, developing ideas through a range of preliminary sketches or models?
RE	Our unit is: Religious Responsibility This term we are thinking about how to face new challenges positively and how religion can help with big global issues such as racism, respect, equality,

Spanish	Our unit is: Do you have a pet? In this lesson pupils will progress to learning how to use the irregular high frequency verb 'I have', along with the conjunction 'and' in order to say which pets they have.
