Music	This week the children will have their first music lesson on Wednesday morning with our lovely assistant head teacher and music lead – Miss Hooper!
Phonics	This week we will begin our phonics learning! We will learn the sounds S, A, T and P. We will begin with identifying the sounds within words and learning how the letters are formed. Soon we will send home some sound mats that link to the sounds the children are learning in school this year, please use these to support your child's learning at home.

RSHE	This term our topic in RSHE is 'Being Me in My World' and this week's focus is 'How Am I Feeling Today?' – in this lesson the children will discuss different emotions they may have felt when starting school, they will work together to come up with ideas of how we can make a friend feel welcome in our school and share with the class how they are feeling in the session.
